Herewith I have the honor of transmitting the application for membership from the Rotary Club of Naples, Italy.

This club was instituted on the 11th day of December 1924.

The history of the organization of this club is as follows: Last spring, Comm. Francisco Bertolini of this city was visiting his brother, Comm. Lorenzo Bertolini of Turin (Organizer of the club in that city) Lorenzo asked his brother to visit the Milan club with him, which he did and became much interested in the Rotary movement. He also met the Extension Committee who furnished him with literature. Another Neapolitan, Cav. Pierto Lorario, had also visited the Milan Club and become interested. They now joined forces and, with the advice of the Extension Committee, increased their numbers until September, when an informal organization was formed and weekly lunches held. The club continued to grow and I was informed that they were ready for Inauguration. I therefore proceeded to Naples and, finding that they had complied with every requirement, Inaugurated the club on Dec. 11th. with 17 charter members. Representatives of the Milan, Turin, Genoa and Rome clubs, also the U.S.-Rotarian Chase, Alabama- were present. The attached Roster list will show you the high standing of its members. Fuller particulars given in the Enclosed letter.

This club has adopted the standard constitution prescribed by Rotary International for local clubs, certified copy attached.

This club has a satisfactory charter list of members as is indicated by the list (~~in duplicate~~) attached to its application.

This club has duly elected its members.
